

# HAGGERTY MUSEUM OF ART TOURS



## **Guided Tours**

Free guided tours are available for elementary, middle, and high school students and adult groups. Tours are available Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Tours require a minimum of 10 students and a maximum of 65. One chaperone is required for every 10 students. Tours are led by museum docents and are approximately 50 minutes in duration.

**All tours must be scheduled at least four weeks in advance.**

## **Self-Guided Tours**

Self-guided tours are also permitted, however reservations are still needed at least four weeks in advance for groups of more than 10 people.

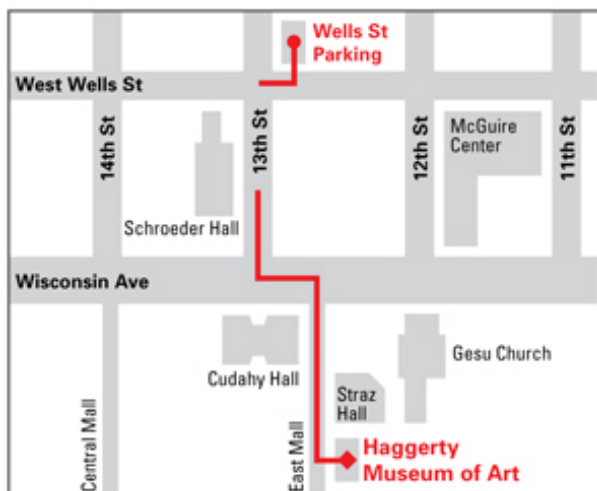

## Directions/Parking

### Location

The Haggerty Museum of Art is located at 13th and Clybourn streets on the Marquette University campus in Milwaukee. It is accessible to people with disabilities.



### Parking

Parking for Haggerty visitors is available in Marquette University's Lot J, accessed from 11th St. between Wisconsin and Clybourn. There are 15 spaces in the 85-space lot dedicated to Haggerty guests on a regular basis and other spaces in Lot J are available on a first-come, first-served basis for museum programs. Overflow parking is available in the [Wells Street Parking Structure](#), entered on Wells just east of 13th St. or at metered spaces on Clybourn between 13th and 15th Streets.

### Student Drop-Off and Bus Parking

Buses should drop students off on the south side of the museum at 13<sup>th</sup> and Clybourn Streets. If buses will be waiting for students while the tour is taking place, street parking is available on St. Paul Avenue.
