Working in collaboration with [Marquette's Educational Opportunity Program](#), each summer the Haggerty hosts a 5-week-long art class for students enrolled in the Upward Bound program. Now in its 14th year, the Haggerty/Upward Bound art program has offered drawing, printmaking, sculpture, painting, ceramics, and video classes. Since 2011, the program has concentrated on drawing, with Milwaukee artist [Ras Ammar Nsoroma](#) teaching the class. This year Nsoroma will use work from *Current Tendencies IV* as inspiration for drawing landscapes and cityscapes.
