Cooperative Access Program

The Libraries are providing this program as a means of improving access for each other's academic communities to the 3,000,000 volume research collections of Marquette University, the Medical College of Wisconsin, and UW-Milwaukee Libraries. In an information intensive era, with spiraling journal costs, proliferating research publications, and increased need for ready access to current scholarship, it is impossible for any single library to meet all user needs. This is particularly true in science, technology, and medical research. For that reason, the three institutions are actively planning ways to increase cooperation in order to minimize the impact of journal cancellations that have unfortunately become a regular feature of the scholarly information world.

The Libraries are exploring additional ways to manage decisions about print and electronic collections to serve you better. We expect to build on this initial effort, and we welcome your suggestions for improvements and closer cooperation.

Users are strongly advised to check hours prior to visiting a library.


