# Marquette University <br> Way Klingler Young Scholar Award 2018 Application 

The purpose of Way Klingler Young Scholar Award is to support promising young scholars in critical stages of their careers. Up to four awards will be given for 2018-19 to full-time regular junior faculty in the three years following their third-year review. The awards are intended to fund \$2,000 in operating cost and to cover a portion of salary to afford the recipient a one-semester release from teaching. The award is competitive and will be selected by the Committee on Research.

Applications including support letters from the department chair and dean are due by January 5, 2018 (Check with your dean's office to confirm the college application deadline). Individuals selected will be notified by February 27, 2018 and will select a Fall 2018 or Spring 2019 research semester by agreement with the dean. A final report is due to the Office of the Provost one month after completion of the research semester.
